WASTE MANAGEMENT TASK FORCE**

The **North Pender** Local Trust Committee is accepting expressions of interest for volunteer positions on the **Waste Management Task Force** “Special Advisory Planning Commission” (official title).

The Task Force will be appointed to **represent the local community** and ensure the process to develop land use regulations for waste transfer facilities is **steered by the community itself**.

The role of the Task Force is to determine **appropriate locations and regulations for waste transfer facilities on North Pender Island**, and make recommendations to the North Pender Island Local Trust Committee.

The duty of the Task Force is to consider the issues from an **enlarged perspective aimed at solutions for the community as a whole**.

The Task Force will be hosting **consultation events** specifically designed for public input. The meetings themselves are not intended to be community consultation events.

Applicants from North and South Pender are invited and will be appointed by the **North Pender Island** Local Trust Committee.

Meetings and conduct of the Task Force will be conducted in accordance with the **North Pender Local Trust Committee Advisory Planning Commission Bylaw** and the **Special Advisory Planning Commission Terms of Reference** (adopted by the NPILTC on April 30, 2015).

The Task Force will meet approximately **seven times** between **June 2015** and **July 2016**.

If you are interested in helping form land use regulations for waste transfer facilities, please submit a letter of interest and your resume **before 4:30 pm June 15, 2015**.
