

Lasqueti Island Local Trust Committee Aging at Home Community Survey

The purpose of this survey is to assess the needs of older adults related to aging at home on Lasqueti Island. Information gathered will be used to make recommendations to the Lasqueti Island Local Trust Committee (LTC) on potential future updates to the Official Community Plan (OCP) and Land Use Bylaw (LUB); and to identify partnerships with community groups and relevant agencies. The survey is part of a project funded by the Union of BC Municipalities and the Lasqueti Island LTC. The results will be presented to the Lasqueti Island LTC in the fall of 2016.

This survey complies with the Personal Information Protection Act which guarantees that information you provide is anonymous and remains confidential. Data will only be used for the purposes of formulating recommendations to the Lasqueti Island LTC.

Please be aware, however, that IP addresses are collected by SurveyMonkey itself, and these IP addresses and other information collected will be stored on SurveyMonkey's servers located outside of Canada. This survey is voluntary and a response is encouraged, not required. Please do not provide any third-party information (i.e. talk about others) in your responses to the survey.
