To Whom it may Concern

I'm writing this letter as an owner of land on Lasqueti Island, Lots 22, 23 and 24 on Spring Bay Road. I have been coming to Lasqueti for over 60 years. My family has been coming to Lasqueti for over 90 years.

I don't understand the need for what you are proposing in putting more restrictions on what we may or may not be able to do with our lots, in relation to setbacks on my property. The foreshore on Lasqueti remains protected, almost exactly the same as it was 60 years ago. To double the setbacks and restrictions from the current 15 metres to 30 metres, would make many lots along the oceanfront, particularly in our area, completely unusable.

I don't continue to come to Lasqueti to have restrictions placed on what I can do to enjoy my time there. I believe what's already put in place has protected the foreshore to the degree it needs to be protected. Any further protection is neither required and would be undesirable for the experience we have on Lasqueti.

As a family, we don't come to Lasqueti to be mired up in restrictions – we come to Lasqueti to get away from all that! So hopefully, we can leave what is in place well enough alone. Let Lasqueti be Lasqueti, as it has been for these many years.

Obviously, we have no objections for improvements in the future, but we don't see this as an improvement, rather we see it as a detriment.
