ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least six months immediately preceding voting day
- resident of OR registered owner of property on Hornby Island for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day, and
- not otherwise disqualified by law from voting.

Resident electors will also be required to produce **two pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce two pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if applicable, written consent from the majority of the property owners.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Qualified electors may vote by mail if they:

- have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting opportunity, OR
- expect to be absent from the Hornby Island Local Trust Area within the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities.

REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

You can request a mail ballot package by filling in an application (available online at www.comoxvalleyrd.ca/election) or submitting the following information to the CVRD office in person or by mail (600 Comox Road, Courtenay, BC V9N 3P6), telephone (250-334-6000), fax (250-334-4358) or email (elections@comoxvalleyrd.ca):

- (1) Full name,
- (2) Residential address,
- (3) Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- (4) Method of receiving your mail ballot package:
 - (a) pick up at CVRD office, OR
 - (b) regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
 - (c) regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package,
- (5) You must indicate whether you will register and vote as a resident or non-resident property elector.

Applications will be received until 4:30 pm on Wednesday, February 27, 2019. The CVRD will send out mail ballot packages starting on or about February 5, 2019.

To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by an election official at the CVRD, 600 Comox Road, Courtenay, BC V9N 3P6 no later than 4:30 pm on Wednesday, February 27, 2019, OR ballots must be hand delivered to the chief election officer at the New Horizons Centre voting place, 1765 Sollans Road, Hornby Island, BC between 8:00 am and 8:00 pm on Saturday, March 2, 2019.
