After a site visit is complete, the Islands Trust Conservancy board will review your proposal as well as a staff report. A decision about your conservation proposal will be made at the next board meeting. All conservation proposals associated with development applications will be considered in a public meeting and not in closed meetings. Landowners transferring land or registering covenants associated with development applications do not qualify for an income tax receipt.
