What are the bylaws about?

The bylaws are intended to allow for the development of a nature protection and environmental education centre on the subject area of the property shown in the sketch map below. The two bylaws will redesignate the Rural portion of the property to Nature Protection, and the Marine designation to a Marine Protection designation as well as rezone the Rural 2 portion of the subject property to a new Environmental Education and Nature Protection zone which would allow for the uses and activities currently permitted by the current TUP and which are reflected in the rezoning application.

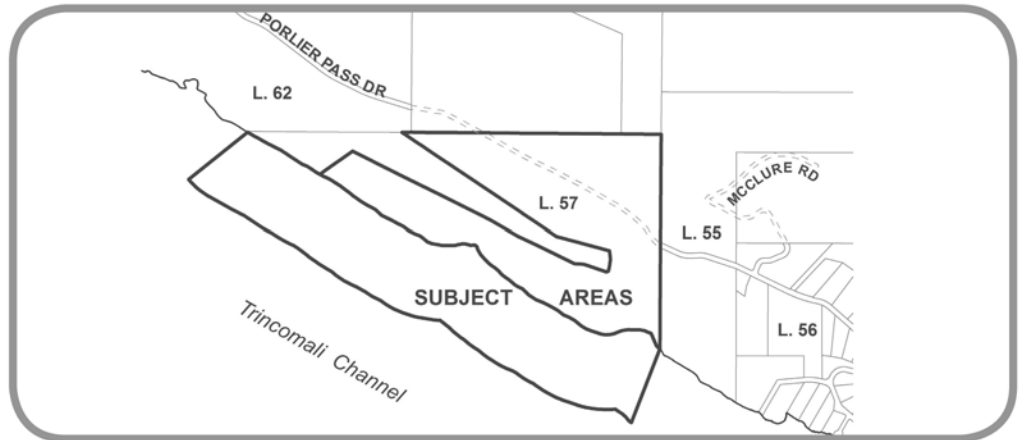
