



Will Wording

The following sample Will clauses provide a few options for charitable giving at Islands Trust Conservancy through your Estate. There are many ways that your legacy can be structured.

Residual Bequest - allows you to make a gift after providing for your family and loved ones.

Sample wording: “I give to the Islands Trust Conservancy*, currently of 200-1627 Fort Street, Victoria, British Columbia, (the residue of my estate) or (___ percent of the residue of my estate) to be used in such a manner as the Islands Trust Conservancy shall, in its sole discretion, determine”.

Specific Bequest - allows you to direct a specific amount of money or a named percentage or portion of your estate to the Islands Trust Conservancy.

Sample wording: “I give to the Islands Trust Conservancy, (___ dollars) or (___ percent of my estate) to be used in such a manner as the Islands Trust Conservancy shall, in its sole discretion, determine”

Contingent Bequest - allows you to identify the Islands Trust Conservancy as a beneficiary of your estate or a portion of your estate, only if your primary beneficiary or beneficiaries predecease you.

Sample wording: “In the event that _____ does not survive me, I give to the Islands Trust Conservancy, (_____ dollars) or (_____ percent of my estate) to be used in such a manner as the Islands Trust Conservancy shall, in its sole discretion, determine”
