#### 4008 - SS-BL-493 - Piers Island Official Community Plan Bylaw Amendment 3.1

Kelly Gesner, Landworks Consultants Inc., presented a staff report dated March 24, 2016 regarding the Piers Island Official Community Plan Update for Greenhouse Gas Emissions (GHG) Reduction Targets.

# 3.2 4014 - Watershed Conservation and Demand Management Plan

Clive Leung, Opus DaytonKnight Consultants Ltd., presented the Watershed Conservation and Demand Management Plan for Salt Spring Island.

There was discussion and the following items were noted:

- include consistent measurement units throughout the plan or add a footnote to explain the criteria where different measurement units are used;
- address the discrepancy between the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure subdivision water supply requirements and Official Community Plan No. 434 water supply requirements in Table 3-9: Comparison of Water Supply Requirements to Metered Consumption Data;
- include a footnote to explain the average water use for 2014/2015 in Table 3-14: Future (2036) Water Demand Estimates in (Millions of) Litres per Day;
- add metric units to Table 3-16: Sensitivity Analysis on Future Demand Maxwell Lake and Table 3-17: Sensitivity Analysis on Future Demand – St. Mary Lake.

The Trustees acknowledged Consultant Clive Leung for the report and requested an electronic copy of the presentation.
