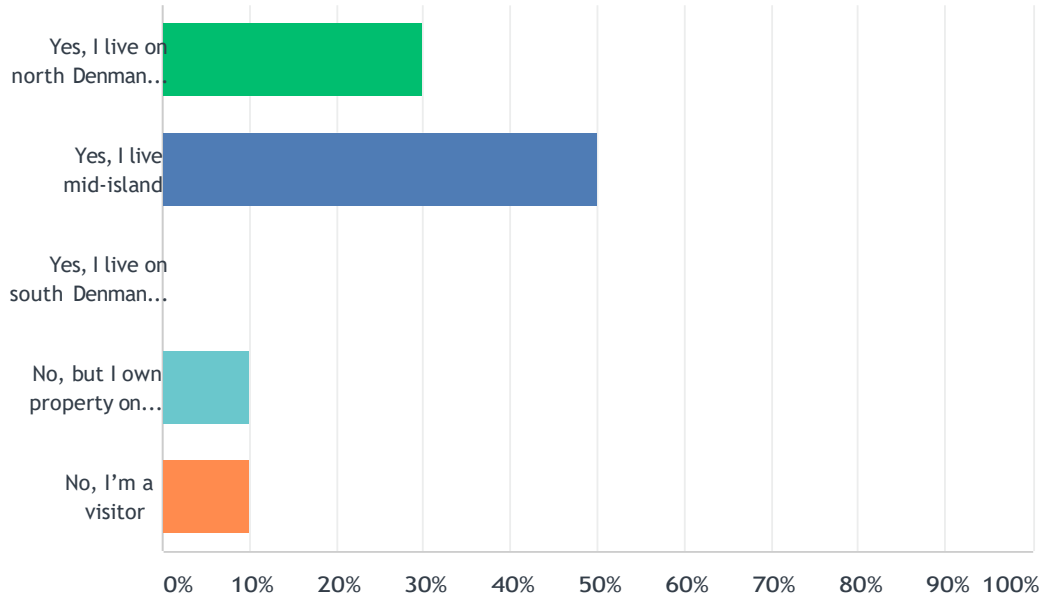


Q1 Are you a resident of Denman Island?

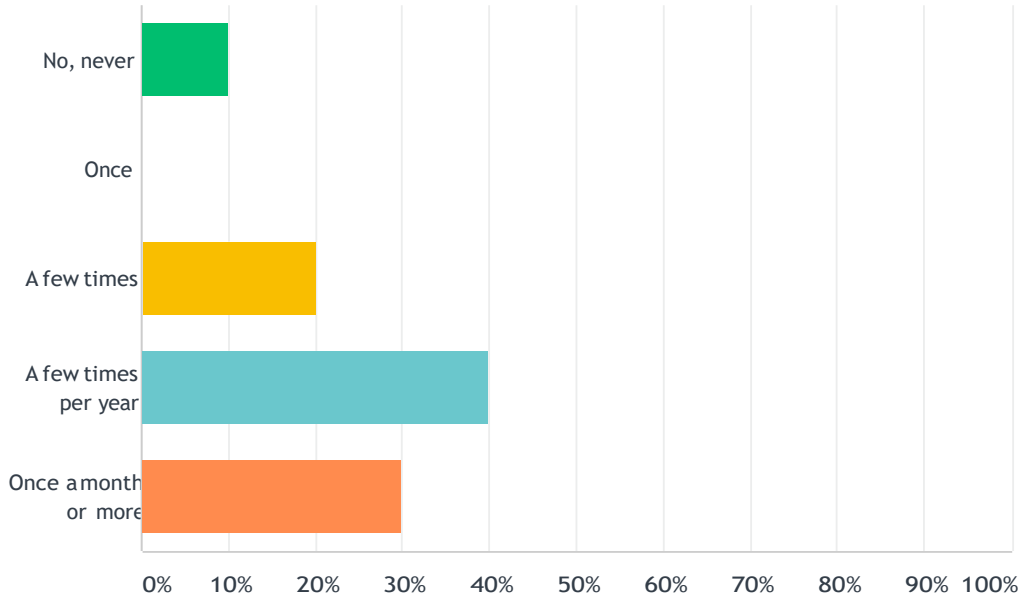

Q2 Have you ever visited Inner Island Nature Reserve? If so, how often?

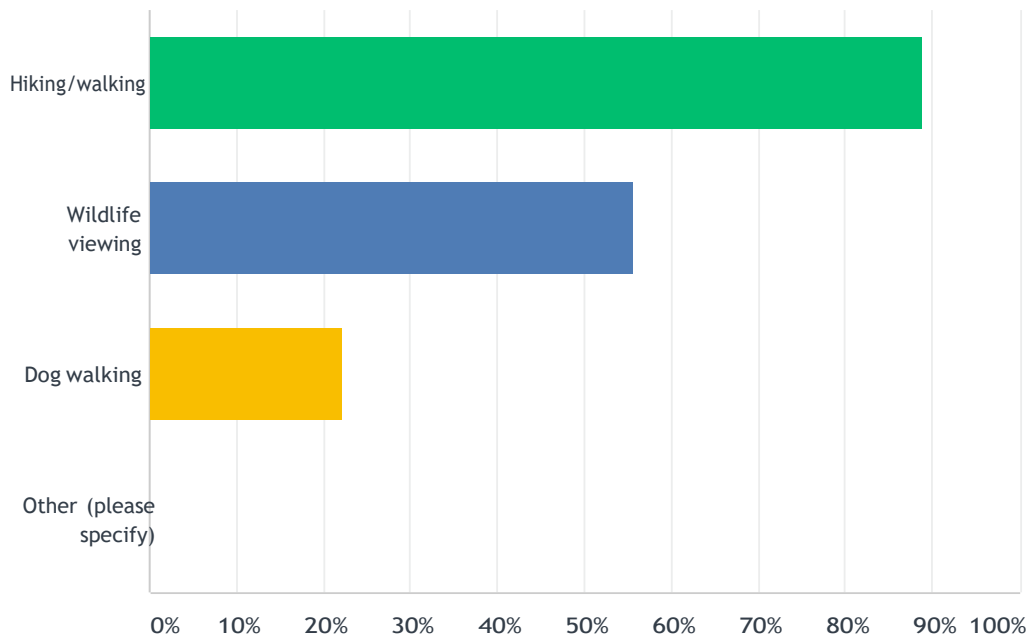

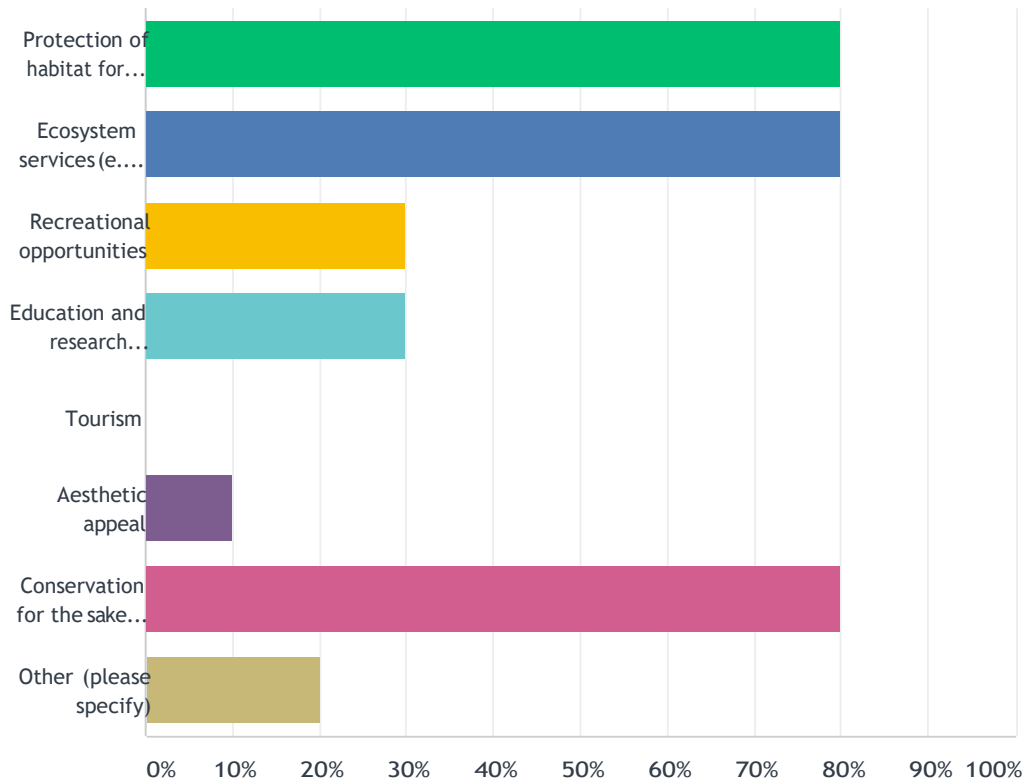
