What is Proposed Bylaw No. 526 about?

Proposed Bylaw No. 526 seeks to change residential permissions in the Agricultural Land Reserve to allow additional dwellings, as well, the bylaw proposes options for farms outside of the Agricultural Land Reserve to build additional farmworker housing.

Proposed Bylaw No. 530 seeks to amend the Salt Spring Island Land Use Bylaw (SS LUB) to allow Accessory Dwelling Units, such as secondary suites, cottages, or garden suites, to be established on an expanded number of properties island-wide.
