Logging and fishing complemented each other with the seasons.

I met my Indigenous wife in the '80s.

I first got into politics with the Pacific Harbour Authority Advisory Committee, and then the National Committee.

I helped start the non-profit that provides insurance for 5,500 volunteers.

At the CRD I pushed for recognition of Coast Salish people who aren't affiliated

with any Nation.

I'm running because I want to see fair application of Trust bylaws, and reconciliation with the First Nations.

I view creative housing solutions and greater food security as a way to create real community and make Galiano more self-sufficient.
